Be sure your team is in Assembly Hall at least 2 hours before they are scheduled to perform.

Team members need to be wearing their ORANGE wristband in order to be admitted to Assembly Hall. If there was a problem and you did not receive your wristbands, the coach should go to the Team Entrance and check with the IDTA rep at the table.

There are Locker Rooms available for team use – those are located off the Tunnel – please plan your time so that you do not take up this space for other teams.

Your team should report to the Warm Up area – upper level no more than 6 teams ahead of your scheduled performance. An IDTA official will be there to direct you when to report to the Tunnel. Please follow the signs to the Warm Up area and to get to the Tunnel.

If your team has a problem with their scheduled picture time – check with VIP Photographers who will be located in the back area of the Tunnel. All teams MUST have their team picture taken by VIP. There will be a picture schedule posted and emailed by Wednesday.

Be sure your entire team is in Assembly Hall no later than 6:40 p.m. – shortly after the last performance we will start the Parade of Teams. We need teams to be together and proceed to the Tunnel – they do not have to go via the Warm Up area!

IDTA will have trainers available in a room off the Tunnel if you need their assistance or help for any reason during the day.

The U of I marks an area for team seating and diligently checks that team members are not in the spectator seating area. Please ask your team members to respect this policy of the U of I.

If you are making payment for your team on March 13, please drop that off at Tabulating which is located in the Tunnel. You should have your application form and payment in an envelope marked with your school and team name!

Please check out the VENDORS on the upper Concourse in Assembly Hall.

If a member of the press is attending to photograph your team, please have them go to the Team Entrance and show their credentials to receive a PRESS wristband.
